As an eco-labelled hostel, Sleep Well has a responsible purchasing policy that takes into account the economic, social and environmental impacts whether in terms of food, supplies, electrical appliances, cleaning products or building materials.

- Organic and fair trade coffee and cocoa (Oxfam Max Havelaar)
- Oxfam snacks and coffee for vending machines
- Favor seasonal and local fruit and vegetables
- Favor meat from Belgian farms
- Exotic fruits from fair trade (Max Havelaer, Demeeter label)
- Fish from responsible fishing (MSC or ASC certified)
- Vegetarian alternatives available
- Printer and photocopier paper, brochures, flyers recycled or from sustainably managed forests (FSC label)
- Wood (furniture and construction) is FSC certified
- Electrical/electronic appliances that are as energy efficient as possible (Save Energy, Energy class A+)
- Water-efficient washing machines and dishwashers
- Eco-labelled paints
- Eco-labelled cleaning products
- Towels and toilet paper made from recycled paper

Sleep Well refers, as far as possible, to labels ensuring materials, foods or products with a lower impact on the environment.
